SUMMARY: The TCTA will be hosting the 4th Free Junior Summer clinic at Olympic Swim & Tennis Club in Warren, Ohio on Saturday, July 31, 2011 from 10 AM to 1 PM. The first three instructors were **Andy Findley** from Erie, Pa, **Ryan Sacchire** the assistant tennis coach at Notre Dame, and **Ron Steele** the Israeli Davis Cup coach. The fourth clinic will have the tandem team of Mr. Casey Vens and Todd Wojtkowski.

Casey Vens is the son of the late Keith Vens of Warren, Ohio and currently teaches math in the Toledo School System. Casey teaches tennis at a Toledo swim and racquet club in summers. After finishing 2nd in the State his senior year with Zach Veres, Casey went to the University of Toledo where he played for coach Al Wermer. Casey's current love is platform tennis, and he is nationally ranked. Casey learned to teach tennis from his father and, before moving to Toledo, he taught several local tennis players including Ryan Trapp, Kevin Trapp, and Todd Wojtkowski.

Todd Wojtkowski is currently the head coach at Case Western Reserve University, which was nationally ranked in Division III for the first time in school history. Todd is a Youngstown native who played tennis at Ursuline H.S. where he qualified for states 3 times (2 times in doubles & once in singles). Todd continued his tennis career at University of Toledo where he played in the top 3 positions his first 3 years. Todd then transferred to The Ohio State University where he red-shirted his first year and played his second year under current coach Ty Tucker. After graduation Todd was the assistant coach at the Citadel for two years before going to CWRU the last two years. Todd currently coaches several nationally ranked juniors at the Skating Club in Cleveland.
